ORDER:

According to Rule 106 (a) of Tamil Nadu Travelling Allowance Rules, a Government Servant deputed to undergo a course of Training, if the training is at fixed centre and the course of training exceeds three months, may draw travelling allowances under the rules for journeys on Transfer. However in cases where the period of training exceeds three months and the Government allow at their discretion stipend or deputation allowance or training allowance for the period of Training.

Travelling allowance as on tour may be drawn for the journeys to and from the training centre but no daily allowance is admissible for the period of halt at the training centre. If the course of training does not exceed three months or is not confined to a particular station, the rules which govern journey on tour shall Daily allowance shall be allowed at full rate for the first 30 days, and three fourth rate for the next 60 days, subject to a minimum limit of Rs.9/- in the case of officers of Grades I and II and Rs.6/- in the case of Officers of Grade TV and below. The increased minimum limit will Grade IV and below. The increased minimum limit, will however, be applicable only for halts outside the state.

2. It has I been found in practice that in the case of two officers of equal grade deputed for training in the same place one for 3 months and the other for more than 3 months from the same date, the former other word the less the period of training Government servants deputed for Training at the following rates:- 🔩

the more

30 days First : E Full Daily Allowance.

1 Next. 60 days 3/4th of Daily Allowance.

: Next 90 days 1/2 Daily Allowance. : No Daily Allowance. Beyond 180 days

The trainees shall be allowed to claim transfer Travelling Allowance During training period beyond 180 days. The trainees shall also be allowed to draw House Rent Allowance and City Compensatory Allowance at the rates admissible to the training place.

3. The following notification will be published in the T_{a} mil Nadu Government Gazette.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309, read with Article 313, of the constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Travelling Allowance Rules (Part II of the Tamil Nadu Manual of Special Pay and allowances, 1976 Edition).

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 106, in sub-Rule(a) for the first paragraph, the following paragraph shall be substitute namely:-

"Government servant deputed to undergo a course of training, may draw travelling allowance as on tour for the journeys to and from the training centre. Daily Allowance is admissible for the period of halt x at training centre at full rate for the first 30 days, three fourth rate for the next 60 days and half rate for the next 90 days. No daily allowance is admissible beyond 180 days. The trainees shall be allowed to claim travelling allowance as on Transfer, if the training period exceeds 180 days. The xxxxx trainees shall also be allowed to draw House Rent Allowance and City Compensatory Allowance at the rates admissible to the Training Place.
