Sub: FUNDAMENTAL RULES - Fundamental Rule 49 - Calculation
of period of additional charge - instructions - issued.

As per Fundamental Rule 49, Additional charge allowance is
admissible upto five months only.

The period of additional charge is calculated for the
first spell of 3 months by adding 3 months to the date of
assumption of additional charge and for the next spell of 2
months by adding thereafter 2 months. It is not correct.
The period of additional charge should be calculated with reference
to ruling under Fundamental Rule 9(18). The method of calculation
of additional charge arrangement for a period of five months
from 26.7.1983 F.N. is illustrated below:

As per Ruling under Fundamental Rule 9(18)

First three months from 26.7.1983.
