Sub: Medical Board - Reconstitution of Medical Board in cases where the Government differ with the views of the first medical Board - Regarding.

Ref: i) From the Director of Medical Services & Family Welfare D.O. Letter Ref. No. 84626/IC/4/82 Dt. 16.3.84.

ii) From the Director of Medical Education letter Ref. No. 66385/MEI/2/84 dt. 29.5.85.

The Government have examined the question of making a provision in the Medical Code for an appeal by the Government against the recommendations of the medical board in cases of invalidating the Government servants from service on Medical grounds in consultation with the Director of Medical Education and Director of Medical Services & Family Welfare, Madras.

2. The Director of Medical Services & Family welfare has stated that if the Government differs from the recommendation of the Medical Board, a provision may be made in the Medical Code to constitute a State High Power Medical Board at Madras consisting of three senior Members including Professor of Medicine, Professor of Surgery and the Professor of that particular speciality in which the candidate is suffering and the decision of the State High Power Medical Board should be treated as final. The members of the State High Power Medical Board may be decided by the Government.

3. But the Director of Medical Education has stated that in para 568 of the Tamil Nadu Medical Code the procedure with regard to the appeals from Government Servant invalidated from service has been laid down. But regarding the procedure to be followed in cases where Government differ with the views of the First Medical Board and propose to reconstitute the original Medical Board, she has stated that there is no need to make any further amendments to the Medical Code as the present standing medical Board in Government General Hospital is already constituted under Government orders consisting of the Professor of Medicine, Professor of Medicine, Professor of Surgery and Specialist concerned in which disease the Government servant is suffering. If the invalidated Government servant appeals to the Government and requests for reconsideration there is already provision in the Medical Code rules under paras 563 and 576 to constitute a Medical Appeal Board with the Director of Medical Education as President and two specialists in the concerned disease.
