Eub: Pension - Sanction order of the Pension sanctioning authorities - certain instructions - regarding.

Ref: From the A.G., Medras 18 Lr.No.PV.7/I/G1/ 1-14/84-85/429, deted 25.9.84.

The Accountant General in his letter cited has brought to the notice of the Government that some of the Fension sanctioning authorities while sending their Pension chacs, were not furnishing information regarding the name of the person to whomf Family Pension is admissible in the event of the death of a Government servant after his retirement. According to the provisions in the Tamil Nadu Pension fules, 1978 in respect of Gazetted and non-Gazetted Government servants orders sanctioning pension and death-cum-Retirement Gratuity will have to be issued in Form Mo.6 by the Pension Sanctioning authority. In the said Form 6, there is a specific provision for furnishing the name of person to whom family Pension is payable in the vent of death of the Government servant. Much difficulty is being experienced by the Accountant General while authorising the payment of family Pension to the beneficiary because of nonfurnishing of the above information in form 6 of the Tamil Nadu Pension Rules, 1978. I am therefore, to request you to ensure that the information required in Form 6 of the said Rules are invariably furnished, so as to enable the Accountant General to authorise the payment without any difficulty and delay.
