CHECK LIST

The **tenderer (one who is participating in tender)** is requested to verify the following before submitting the tender.

1. This tender document in original or downloaded shall be properly bound and the tenderer must initial on all pages of this document and to be submitted.
2. The Tenderers are requested to sign in all the pages failing which the offer will not be considered.
3. The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 69,000/- (Rupees Sixty Nine Thousand only) shall be enclosed in the Cover A and, in case of sealed tenders, 20 % of quoted amount shall be enclosed in the Cover B.
